Important Information:

- ✓ Deadline to respond to renewal offers was April 15, 2025



New Student Applicants

Priority Period Awardees

Important Information:

- ✓ Eligible new student applicants who applied between February 6 – March 6 were offered an Opportunity Scholarship award on March 28
- ✓ Deadline to respond to the offer was April 18

Tips:

- ✓ Direct parents to their To-Do List to review any award offers
- ✓ If no award is received, verify the 'eligibility' section to confirm student eligibility
- ✓ Keep monitoring notifications for additional updates.

New Student Opportunity Applicants

Important Information:

- ✓ The priority application period has closed but parents can still apply
- ✓ There is no closing date (at this time)
- ✓ Families that apply after the priority period are awarded in order of application date as funds are available, after renewal and priority period applicants.



How to Determine Your Award Tier


Where is it?

Use the Pending Awards Report to ...

- ✓ Review the names of Renewal & New Students who have chosen your school
- ✓ Review each student's **Award Tier**
- ✓ Keep track of who you should NOT be charging tuition in the spring, for the following year (*funds that will be covered by the scholarship*)

Are students missing from your Pending Awards Report?

You'll need to talk to the parent.
Ask them the questions on the next
slide!



Are students missing from your Pending Awards Report?

Reach out to your parent FIRST to ask:

- 1.) Did the parent miss a deadline for a required task?
- 2.) Did the parent select your school?
- 3.) Did the parent decline their student's award offer?
- 4.) Did the parent let the award offer expire without responding?
- 5.) Did the parent accidentally misreport their answer to an eligibility question on their renewal or new student application?
 - Not living in North Carolina*
 - In college full-time*
 - Graduated from High School*
 - Too old/young for program funding*
 - In Pre-K*

If the parent answers YES to any of these, advise the parent to email us for support!

All new students appear on this report, whether they are awarded or not. (*Remember, no renewal students are included.*)

The main piece of information you can use is the **student status**.

We'll explain what these statuses mean on the next slide.

New Student Report: *student statuses*

- **Accepted** = parent has accepted the student's award offer
- **Awarded** = student has been offered an award, but the parent has not responded (the award offer is still available)
- **Qualified** = student is eligible but has not been offered an award*
- **Ineligible** = student is not eligible for an award
- **Application Incomplete** = the parent started but did not complete the application

**Students whose parents did not respond to the award offer also appear as Qualified once the award offer expires. These students are not on the waitlist.*

Summary

Pending Awards Report

- Shows both Renewal & New Students
- Students don't appear on this report in certain circumstances; missed deadline/chose different school, etc... Ask your parents!
- Shows award tier

New Student Report

- Shows only New Students
- Shows all new students who selected your school (with their current status)
- Shows award tier

Providing Assistance

- ✓ Refer parents to our program website: <https://www.k12.ncseaa.edu/>
- ✓ Give parents access to a school computer so they can login to MyPortal and help them scan documents they must submit.
- ✓ Remind parents to login to MyPortal weekly to check their To-Do List & Notifications. *Deadlines matter!*
- ✓ Connect new parents with other families who have experience with the K12 Scholarships.

Deadlines

April - October

Opportunity Scholarship funding is subject to verification for Income & Residency.

If a household is selected for Income or Residency verification, we have [resources](#) to help the family complete the process.

**REMINDER: Check your 'Not Yet Certified' & 'Not Yet Endorsed' Rosters TODAY!
Get those students completed.**

TIP:

Don't forget to **Certify** & **Endorse** new students who transfer to your school throughout the year. Funds cannot be released until these two steps happen.
