

Transferring Schools between Semesters?

Need to transfer schools?

A student's award **can** be transferred to another eligible nonpublic school.

Award funds can only be sent to two schools per semester.

The amount of available funds that can be sent to the new school depends on the number of weeks the student has attended the previous school. The chart below shows the percentage of award funds a school is entitled to keep based on the number of weeks a student has attended.

Weeks attended	Percent to return
2 weeks or less	100%
3 weeks	90%
4 weeks	80%
5 weeks	70%
6 weeks	60%
7 weeks	50%
More than 7 weeks:	0%

Student Transfer Form



Submit a student transfer form:

1. If your student has used funding at their current school and is withdrawing to transfer to another Direct Payment School.
2. If you would like to cancel your student's Opportunity Scholarship award



Do NOT submit a student form:

1. If your student has not officially withdrawn
2. If your student has NOT attended a private school

Need a single term award?


Single Term Award

- Parents have the option to convert a full year award offer to a single term award offer in the event the student will not enroll in a participating school for a portion of the school year.
- The student will forfeit their Fall 2025 funding (receive half of the annual award) but will be able to use their Spring 2026 funding at a [direct payment school](#).
- Students must be enrolled and attending an eligible school no later than March 1st, 2026, to use Spring funding. If students are not attending by this date, their scholarship will be cancelled.
- To request a single term award parents should send a help request message or email the Opportunity Scholarship Program (OpportunityScholarships@ncseaa.edu).



In order to be eligible for the Opportunity Program, State law requires that the student live in North Carolina with a Parent who is currently domiciled in North Carolina. The State domicile requirements for the Program mirror the domicile requirements for a student to attend a North Carolina public school. The Parent must meet the State domicile requirements no later than the beginning of the 2025-2026 school year.

At the beginning of the 2025-2026 school year, you will be required to certify that you are domiciled in North Carolina. A person's domicile is generally the place that a person regards as his or her permanent, established home, and is the place he or she intends to remain. Examples of demonstrating a person's domicile includes where a person pays taxes, holds bank accounts, votes, has a driver's license, works, and physically resides. As with student enrollment in the public schools, there are occasional exceptions to those general requirements for the Program.

For verification purposes, you may also be asked by the State Education Assistance Authority (SEAA) to provide documentation that you meet the State residency requirement and SEAA may verify that information with other State agencies. If SEAA determines that your domicile certification contains falsified information, you may be subject to administrative, civil, or criminal penalties.

Not disclosing your income will automatically place your student in Award Tier 4, which is the base award amount. The Award Tiers are based on previous tax year (2024) household income. A student's Award Tier determines the award amount.
